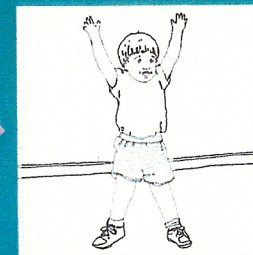
1. They play games just by running around.

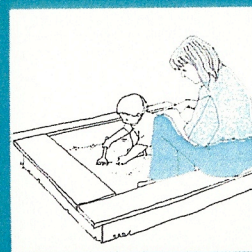
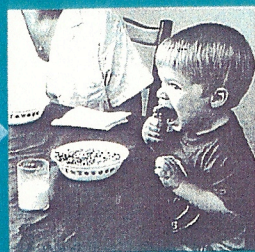

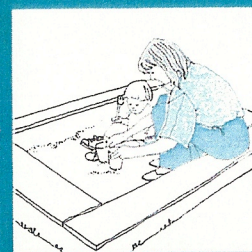

2. Give them clean sand or soil to play with.



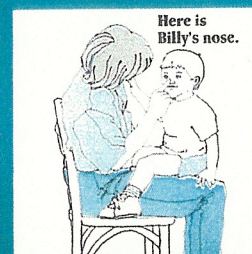

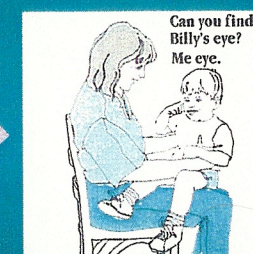
1. Help them learn the parts of the body.
