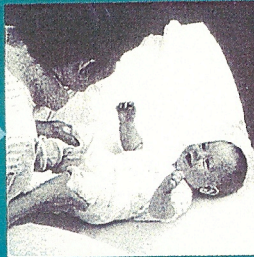


2 to 3 months

3. They will smile at other people they know.

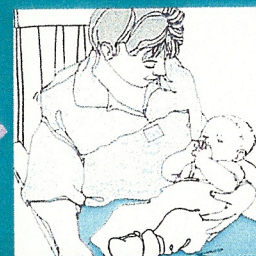


4. But they save the biggest smile for you.

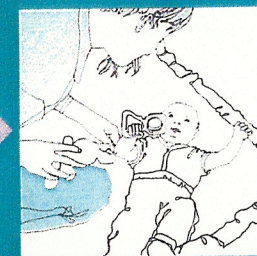
Your infant is discovering how to use their hands. They love to play with their hands and watch their hands come together.

2. They love to try and put their hands together.

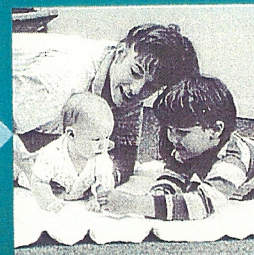


3. Let them try to grab things.

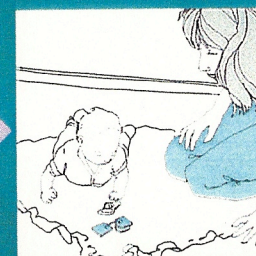


4. Let them help you hold the bottle while you feed them.
